The Medfield Lions will be presenting the MVP trophy at Medfield High School's Thanksgiving Day football game.

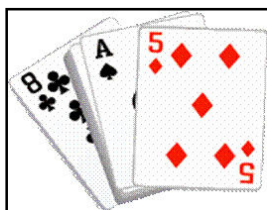
